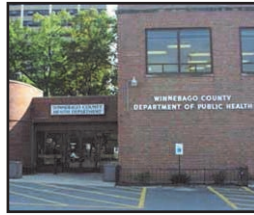
Eligibility requirements:

Women's Health Services

Eligibility requirements:

No one is denied services due to an inability to pay.

Fees are assessed based on the services needed, with adjustments made depending on the individual or family income.

Third party billing for insurance, Medicaid or Medicare is available.

WIC Nutrition Services

Program for Women, Infants & Children

Providing nutrition education, breastfeeding support, food coupons and referrals to social & health care services for pregnant women, infants & children up to the age of 5.



Eligibility requirements:

Women must be pregnant, breastfeeding or recently delivered a baby. Children must be under 5 years of age. Proof of residence, income and medical/nutritional need will be determined before enrollment.

Family Health Services

Supportive & community referral services for pregnant women & infants.

Provides information and resources for prenatal needs & infant health and care.



Health education, Assessment of needs, In-home follow-up, Link to WIC program, Referral to other agencies, Link to Teen Parent Services, Link to services for high-risk infants, Link to intensive prenatal care, Help applying for medical cards & All Kids.



Eligibility requirements:

If you are a resident of Winnebago County, and are pregnant, have a child under the age of one, are on Medicaid, or part of a low-income family you may be eligible to enroll in the Family Case Management program.
